#### Noah's Ark Wish List

- Kuranda Dog Beds – These are what we use in our dog kennels to allow the dogs to rest off the floor. They are easy to clean, sturdy, and the dogs love them. You can donate online at <http://kuranda.com/donate/8571> and the beds will be shipped directly to us.
- Towels, blankets, dog/cat beds, etc. – We can use most everything as long as it can be machine washed (no pillows, electric blankets, couch cushions, large comforters or crochet-type blankets for safety and sanitary reasons).
- Dog/Cat toys and treats – Hard Kong-type toys for dogs are in great demand! We get a LOT of donated Milk-Bone type biscuit treats, but dogs seem to prefer the higher value softer treats, especially when they're nervous.
- Dog/Cat food – We keep the animals' daily diet consistent, and don't mix all kinds of dry food, but it is easy to donate the kind of food we do need. We use Diamond Premium adult and puppy. Our main supplier for dog food is Circle S Feed, and not only do they know exactly what we need, but they will even deliver it to us and save you from lugging heavy bags out. Cats are fed 4Health All Life Stages from Tractor Supply. Tractor Supply also carries our dog food, and they have online ordering available as well. We can always use soft/canned food, and are not at all picky about brand. Higher quality (high protein, grain-free, etc.) foods both dry and canned are also very welcome as some animals require extra or special nutrition. We will accept any kind of donated food, however - even if not the brands we generally feed - for distribution through a pet food pantry program to help low-income pet owners as well.
- Cat Litter – The inexpensive, non-clumping clay litter is what we use daily, sometimes 100 lbs in one day if we are full! All litter types are still appreciated and can be used in foster homes even if it's not our shelter type.
- Miscellaneous animal supplies – Bowls, feeders, cat scratchers, litter boxes, food scoops/storage bins, pooper scoopers, small animal cages, grooming supplies/equipment, "other" animal feed/bedding (rabbit, ferret, chicken...) etc.
- Crates – The plastic travel crates are our favorite for transport, and we can use any size from XXS to XXL. We can also use the collapsible wire kennels and soft-sided carry bags as well – again, all sizes are appreciated.
- Collars, leashes, harnesses – any size, and "gently used" are fine.
- Assorted "daily use" items – dish soap, scrub sponges, Clorox wipes, hand sanitizer, ziplock baggies (all sizes), laundry detergent, bleach, paper towels (you would not believe how many paper towels we go through!), toilet paper, buckets, pens, Sharpies, highlighters, trash bags, copy paper (white or any colored), etc.

Gently used items are great – the animals are easy to please, and they don't care if their items aren't new with tags! If you have something to donate and are unsure whether or not we can use it, please just give us a call and we'll be happy to answer any questions you might have!
